



## Guide to Continuing Education Units

AFCC's 45th Annual Conference offers continuing education opportunities as follows:

**Psychologists:** AFCC is approved by the American Psychological Association to sponsor continuing education for psychologists. AFCC maintains responsibility for this program and its content. The program is eligible for up to 22.5 hours of continuing education:

- All sessions, except for Pre-Conference Institute 6 and Workshop 30

**Lawyers:** The conference is:

- Approved by the Oregon State bar for up to 17.25 general credits, program # 2222\*12
- Approved by the Washington State Bar Association for up to 22.50 continuing legal education (CLE) credits, Activity ID # 204122
- Accredited by the Law Society of Upper Canada for 22.5 hours towards the professional development requirement for certification

**British Columbia lawyers:** Attendance at the parts of this program relating to the study or practice of law can be recorded as continuing education in completing your Annual Report to the Law Society of British Columbia.

**Mental Health Professionals:** The conference program has been approved by the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) for up to 22.5 contact hours, Provider ID# 886 478 123. NASW has endorsement of 41 state licensure boards; however, individuals will need to verify approval with their credentialing or licensing boards.

**Mediators:** All conference sessions are eligible for continuing education units through the Association for Conflict Resolution (ACR).

**To obtain a certificate of conference attendance to use to apply for continuing education with one's accrediting institution, follow these steps:**

1. Sign up for a certificate of conference attendance at the AFCC Registration Desk. There is a processing fee of \$10 for AFCC members and \$15 for non-members. *The certificate will verify attendance at conference sessions and may be used to apply for continuing education credits with the registrant's accrediting institution.*
2. Fill out and sign the "Verification of Attendance" form on the reverse side and return it to the AFCC Registration Desk. Your certificate will arrive in the mail in 3-4 weeks.
3. Psychologists and social workers must sign in and out at each session attended. Separate sign in sheets will be provided at each eligible session.
