About the Symposium

The AFCC Symposium on Child Custody is a focused, interdisciplinary program for professionals working with families experiencing separation, divorce, and child custody issues. The Symposium provides a direct opportunity to connect with judges, lawyers, psychologists, mediators, custody evaluators, parenting coordinators, court service professionals, academics, and other family justice professionals.

All requests for refunds must be made in writing. Written notice of cancellation received by email, or postmarked by October 1, 2026, will be issued a full refund minus a \$300 USD service fee. No refunds or credits will be issued for cancellations received after October 1, 2026.

Sponsor / Exhibitor Agreement

Registration, attendance, or participation constitutes consent to adhere to the [AFCC Code of Conduct Policy](#).

Sponsors and exhibitors assume full responsibility and agree to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless AFCC, the Rosen Centre Hotel, its owners, and each of their respective parent organizations, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, officers, directors, and agents from and against all claims, losses, or damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines, and attorney's fees arising out of or caused by the sole negligence of the sponsor or exhibitor or its employees or agents.

Sponsors and exhibitors shall obtain and maintain during the term of the installation and use of the exhibit premises comprehensive general liability insurance and contractual liability insurance. Sponsors and exhibitors acknowledge that neither AFCC nor the conference venue maintains insurance covering exhibitor property and that it is the sole responsibility of exhibitors to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering any losses.

AFCC will not be liable for fulfillment of this agreement if exhibit space cannot be provided due to damage to the building or exhibit space caused by fire, water, smoke, accident, strikes, the authority of law, or any other cause beyond its control, including a global pandemic. In the event of cancellation due to one of those causes, AFCC will reimburse sponsors and exhibitors for fees paid less all legitimate expenses incurred by AFCC in connection with the exhibits.

Sponsors and exhibitors are responsible for any charges incurred for special services or requirements including, but not limited to, electrical service, power strips and extension cords, audio-visual equipment, internet, telephone lines, table coverings, and packaging or handling fees. Such fees are at the sponsor's or exhibitor's expense, and AFCC is not responsible for additional costs.

Exhibitors must confine all demonstrations and promotional activities to the exhibitor's assigned exhibit space. No signs or displays may be placed in common or conference areas, or in a way that blocks other exhibit tables. Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining any necessary state or local permits, licenses, or certificates.

Exhibitor registration includes one full Symposium registration for the person staffing the exhibit table. Additional representatives must purchase an additional exhibitor registration to attend or participate in any Symposium function, including sessions, plenary sessions, meals, receptions, or networking events. AFCC is not offering complimentary "exhibit only" staffing registrations for this Symposium. Unless otherwise approved by AFCC, no more than two people may staff an exhibit table at any time.

Anyone attending a conference function must be registered for the conference and must wear their name badge at all times.
