

AFCC Content Access Terms

AFCC strives to offer a wide range of training highlighting different research, advocacy positions, policies, practices, programs, and ideas. Some aspects of this training may be evidence-based, while other aspects may report on innovations still in development, emerging practices, or policy initiatives. The goal of this training is to enhance learning while encouraging respectful inquiry, discussion, and debate consistent with AFCC organizational values. AFCC does not necessarily endorse or support the opinions of the presenters and recognizes there may be differing opinions and/or alternative interventions that are not addressed in this specific program.

These live presentations, recordings, and associated materials are licensed for your personal, non-transferable use only. Downloading, copying, sharing, text/data mining, or using any portion for AI training or prompts is prohibited. By registering for, attending, or accessing any AFCC content, you agree to the Content Access Terms below.

A. License & Permitted Use

AFCC grants the original registrant or purchaser a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to attend live presentations and/or stream recordings, and to access associated materials (including slides, handouts, and chat transcripts), solely for personal viewing and noncommercial educational use. No other rights are granted.

B. Prohibited Uses (no exceptions without AFCC's prior written consent)

1. Copy, download, record, or reproduce any audio, video, live presentation, slides, chat, or materials (including via screen-capture, screenshot, photography, or "save video" tools).
2. Share, resell, sublicense, lend, or otherwise provide access to any third party (including colleagues, listservs, or classrooms), or display publicly.
3. Create transcripts, captions, notes, summaries, datasets, embeddings, or derivatives of any portion of the live or recorded content or associated materials.
4. Perform text and data mining (TDM), scrape, or otherwise ingest any portion of the content or materials into AI or machine-learning systems, including but not limited to model training, fine-tuning, evaluation, or prompt-based generation.
5. Input, upload, paste, or otherwise expose any portion of the content or materials (including slides, speaker handouts, or live session notes) to AI tools (e.g., ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, Copilot, Whisper, transcription bots), except solely to enable accessibility tools personally used by the licensed viewer (see Section D).
6. Modify, edit, translate, or make derivative works from the content or materials.
7. Remove or obscure any copyright, trademark, confidentiality, watermark, or rights-management notices.
8. Circumvent digital rights management, streaming protections, or any technical measures controlling access.
9. Use the content or materials for commercial purposes, endorsements, or advertising.
10. Attendance at an event for documentation or collection of content for the purpose of public dissemination, administrative grievances, or litigation against the AFCC is a violation of the limited license and may result in removal from events or other legal action.

C. Ownership & Reservation of Rights

All content, including live presentations, recordings, slides, handouts, and related materials, is © AFCC. AFCC reserves all rights not expressly granted. No transfer of ownership occurs.

D. Accessibility Exception

You may use personal, on-device accessibility features (e.g., screen readers, closed captions generated by the AFCC player or venue) solely for your private use. Cloud services that retain, index, or reuse content are not permitted. E. Confidentiality & Sensitive Content

Live presentations, recordings, and associated materials may include case examples and sensitive professional content. You must treat all content as confidential, for professional development only, and comply with your jurisdiction's ethical obligations.

F. Term; Suspension; Termination

AFCC may limit, suspend, or terminate access immediately for suspected violations. Upon termination, you must cease all use and certify deletion of any copies, notes, or derivatives (including transcripts and materials from live sessions).

G. Compliance, Monitoring & Audit

To protect presenters and AFCC intellectual property, AFCC may employ watermarks, access tokens, logging, and other technical measures for both live and recorded content. You consent to such measures for rights protection and fraud prevention.

H. Remedies

You acknowledge that unauthorized use of any AFCC content or materials may cause irreparable harm. AFCC may pursue injunctive relief, specific performance, damages, statutory damages, and recovery of attorneys' fees, in addition to account termination and revocation of CE eligibility.

I. Takedowns & Reporting

- **Disruptive Conduct:** This includes the unauthorized use of proprietary event information on social media to disparage the program or its participants.

- **No Refund Policy:** In the event of removal for a violation of these Terms, no refunds or credits will be issued.
