

AFCC Recording Access Terms

These recordings are licensed for your personal, non-transferable viewing only. Downloading, copying, sharing, text/data mining, or using any portion for AI training or prompts is prohibited. By accessing these videos you agree to the Recording Access Terms below.

A. License & Permitted Use

AFCC grants the original registrant/purchaser a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to stream the purchased or complimentary recording(s) solely for personal viewing and non-commercial educational use. No other rights are granted.

B. Prohibited Uses (no exceptions without AFCC's prior written consent)

1. Copy, download, record, or reproduce any audio, video, slides, chat, or materials (including via screen-capture or “save video” tools).
2. Share, resell, sublicense, lend, or otherwise provide access to any third party (including colleagues, listservs, or classrooms), or display publicly.
3. Create transcripts, captions, notes, summaries, datasets, embeddings, or derivatives of any portion of the recordings or materials.
4. Perform text and data mining (TDM), scrape, or otherwise ingest any portion of the recordings or materials into AI or machine-learning systems, including but not limited to model training, fine-tuning, evaluation, or prompt-based generation.
