SPONSOR / EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT

Exhibitors assume entire responsibility and agree to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless AFCC, AAML, the Hilton San Francisco, its owners, and each of their respective parent organizations, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, officers, directors, and agents against all claims, losses, or damages to person or property, governmental charges or fines, and attorney's fees arising out of or caused by the sole negligence of the exhibitor or its employees or agents.
